English

The children will study:

- *Tar Beach by Faith Ringgold, in which the children explore the theme of 'freedom'.
- *The Iron Man by Ted Hughes in which the children will explore the devices of mystery and suspense.

Science - States of Matter

This unit teaches about the differences between solids, liquids and gases, classifying objects and identifying their properties. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate the weight of a gas. Furthermore, they will have chance to find the ideal temperature to melt chocolate. They will explore in-depth how water changes state, exploring melting, freezing, condensing as well as a particular focus on evaporation.

Computing - Scratch

Humanities History

In this unit, children head back in time to find out how the ancient civilisations of the world developed. The differences and the similarities between them, and their art and culture.

Geography

The class will be looking at mountain ranges around the world. We will look at the advantages and disadvantages of living in a mountainous area, and comparing mountains in the UK to mountains in the Andes.
