#### **English**

# <u>Fiction:</u> The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe:

The children explore the idea that a character can change over time. They will develop the skills of prediction including evidencing from the text. They will write a poem about a sweet that bewitches a main character, an imaginary conversation between 2 characters and write in role.

#### Narrative: The Matchbox Diary

The children will discover a set of matchboxes containing some of the mementoes from the story. After writing predictions about what the objects might relate to, the children will listen to the story in stages.

#### P.E. - Real PE

Children continue to develop athletic and gymnastic skills that will be essential in their ability to play sports successfully.

### Computing - Word Processing

The Children will learn about the tools of Microsoft Word. How to present data, and how to crop and load pictures from the internet to documents, and make text fit around them.

#### Science - Animals including Humans

This unit focuses on the digestive system in humans and animals and the functions of teeth. Children will learn more about herbivores, carnivores and omnivores in the context of teeth, digestion and the food chain. In addition, they will extend their understanding of food chains to more complex chains and food webs.

# Religious Education - Are all churches the same?
