English

Non-Fiction - The Story of Tutankhamun by Patricia Cleveland-Peck:

The children begin by exploring the history of Tutankhamun and writing reports about Ancient Egypt before going on to find out about Howard Carter and exploring the stories and legends about the curse of Tutankhamun's tomb. It culminates with children writing a biography of Tutankhamun.

Non-Fiction - Shackleton's Journey by William Grill:

The children will learn about Ernest Shackleton's journey to Antarctica and begin by writing telegrams home from the ship, conversations between crew members and finish this unit writing a newspaper article.

Computing - Word Processing

This unit is aimed at teaching basic and word processing and text formatting skills. The children will learn about formatting images and organising content into and effective layout. They will learn new skills and techniques and apply them to creating a range of different word documents.

P.E. Real PE

Children continue to develop athletic and gymnastic skills that will be essential in their ability to play sports successfully.

Science - Animals, including humans

The children explore ways to identify, sort, group and classify living things. They will use classification keys to group, identify and name living things from the local habitat and beyond. It introduces children to the idea that environments are subject to man-made and natural changes and these changes can have a significant impact on living things.

<u>Year Four</u> Half Term 6

<u>Creative Curriculum Topic - Ancient Egypt</u>

This Ancient Egypt unit teaches the children in depth about the achievements of this ancient civilisation. They will learn about how and where the ancient Egyptians lived, what was important to the daily lives of ancient Egyptians, who Tutankhamun was and how mummies were made. The children will also learn about how Egyptian people used hieroglyphs to communicate and compare the powers of different gods.

Maths

Geometry - position and direction Measurement - area and perimeter Consolidation of units taught this year.

Religious Education - Prayer

The aim of this unit is to ensure that the children know that prayer is a way of communicating with God and to know that Christians believe that God listens and responds.

Heartsmart- Fake is a Mistake

Can you tell the truth even if it means you may get into trouble? The children learn that telling the truth is always the right option. Being honest about yourself, and others is the best way to be.

Music - Violin

The children continue to learn how to play the violin during this half term, culminating in a concert to show their skills. This will be taught by a specialist music teacher.
