English - Evolution & Inheritance

The Promise (2 wks) Sequel and report

Can We Save the Tiger (3 wks) Letter, explanation, persuasive poster, persuasive speech, balanced argument

The Hidden Forest (3 wks) Non-chronological report in the form of a letter to a character and balanced discursive piece.

Geography – Oceans

The children will study: Oceans and seas, Oceans and trade, Oceans and climate, Oceans and land masses, Oceans and climate change and The human impact on oceans.

History – Anglo Saxons

The children will study: Attacks by land and sea, How did the migrations happen? Connected kingdoms, Not Angles but angels! Mercia: a changing kingdom, What was found at Sutton Hoo?

Computing - Spreadsheets

Children will continue with spreadsheets learning. They will design their own spreadsheet, with ideas and direction provided for particular purposes.

French – School Life

Children will work on time & school routines, including in complex sentences. They will justify opinions on school subjects using 'because', recall numbers 1-100 & learn about cultural aspects around Christmas.

Science – Animals, including humans

Children will:

- *Learn about the three main parts of the circulatory system and the job of the heart;
- *Learn about what blood is comprised of and how it is transported around the body; *Carry out an investigation to explore how heart rate is affected by exercise;
- *Recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.

Music – Developing Ensemble Skills

Children will develop performing as an ensemble. They will gain confidence, so when they are playing together they use dynamics & expression, and read a notated instrumental part. They will be able to listen to one another and follow the leader. By changing the dynamics of music, they will make the music more interesting. They will learn that gradual changes from soft to loud (crescendo) or from loud to soft (decrescendo) can help make music more exciting.
