English

*Winter's Child by Angela McAllister

The children will explore the theme of the story, making predictions about what might happen if you are not careful what you wish for. Children continue to explore the themes and language of the text, particularly identifying noun phrases and prepositional phrases and how they are used to create images. Children go on to predict what might happen after the story and write their own simple sequel, applying the grammatical skills learnt.

*The Selfish Giant by Oscar Wilde

The children will explore the text through a range of immersion and engagement activities and will write a range of texts, including diaries, letters, posters, reports, and their own versions (narratives).

P.E. - Real PE

We will be learning dynamic balance skills using lunges and fluid motion. We will also be improving ball skills using hand to eye co-ordination.

Art - Collage

The class will explore collage by artists such as Matisse and Warhol, and creating designs of their own for display.

Science - Electricity

Children will learn about what electricity is and how it was discovered. They will identify which appliances use electricity in their homes and how to keep themselves safe. Children will construct circuits, start to create pictorial circuits, and conduct an investigation into how easily different types of switches can break, and reconnect a circuit.

Curriculum Web Year Four Half Term 3

Humanities

Geography: Coastal processes and landforms.

The children will study the effects of erosion, and how it can create coastal landforms. We will look especially at the Jurassic Coast, west Wales and the Indian Ocean.

History: Roman Britain. We will be looking at the Roman invasion of Britain, how the British rebelled and life on Hadrian's Wall.

Music - Violin

The children will continue to learn how to play the violin during this half term. Combining how to find the rhythm, develop an increased range of notes, and reinforce bowing technique.
