English

<u>Fantasy Worlds - The Lion, the Witch and</u> the Wardrobe by

C.S. Lewis:

The children begin by exploring the idea that a character can change over time, by using predictions, we will see what the class expect to happen at different junctures of the story. This will improve their powers of inference and interpretation.

Poetry - The Jabberwocky by Lewis Carroll:

The children will look at entymology and morphology before creating their own nonsense poem based on the famous creature created be Lewis Carroll.

Computing - Word Processing

We will continue to teach word processing, text formatting skills and organising content into and effective layout. We will then draw on all the skills we have learned this year to create a character for a computer game.

<u>P.E.</u>

Children continue to develop athletic and gymnastic skills, we will be learning to chase, throw and catch a rolling ball.

D&T - Edible Garden

We will learn how to grow, and prepare for eating herbs and vegetables. Includes tasting sessions!

Science - Animals, including humans

The children explore ways to identify, sort, group and classify living things. They will use classification keys to group, identify and name living things from the local habitat and beyond. It introduces children to the idea that environments are subject to man-made and natural changes.

Humanities-History

Continuing our theme from last term we will be looking at how Islam spread, and it's influence as it entered Europe through Spain. We will look at the architecture and history of Cordoba.

Geography
